This year's Great Glass Art Escape will be taking place entirely in the Toledo Museum of Art's Glass Pavilion – a building that has walls made entirely of glass!



There will be lots of people in attendance taking part in different activities inside of the museum, including musical performances. There might be a lot of noise throughout the event.

If I get lost or need assistance, I can ask for help from Toledo Museum of Art staff members who are wearing black and white lanyards.

I can watch glass blowing demonstrations in the Glass Pavilion Hot Shop inspired by Fairytales and Fables. I might feel the heat from the furnace and smell the molten glass and other materials used by the glass artists.



Movies will be playing on loop in the GlasSalon, including Happy Feet and Frozen 2!



There is an exhibition on display in the Glass Pavilion: *Radiance and Reverie: Jewels from the Neil Lane Collection.* I can see jewelry from throughout history! The exhibition is free for museum members and \$10 per person for non-members.



There are lots of activities happening at Great Glass Art Escape! I can create art with the Family Center on the move in the GlasSalon, or participate in story time in the Reflection Room.



I can purchase something to eat or drink at the Hot Drink Bar with Cookie Take-Home Kits
